Wesleyan Holiness Women Clergy Conference

7 Days Left for Super Early Bird Registration!

Register by 11:59pm EDT on October 15 to take advantage of Super Early Bird pricing for E2024 and save \$115 off the regular registration cost. Discounts are also available for students and first-time WHWC conference attendees.

The District Advisory Board has approved \$200 of scholarship assistance to the **first 25 female clergy** serving in an active assignment or female lay leaders (with their pastor's recommendation) who register for the E2024 Wesleyan Holiness Women Clergy Conference. All they have to do is submit their proof of paid registration to the Florida District Resource Center for reimbursement.

E2024 will be held March 7-9, 2024 at the Hyatt Regency in Dallas, TX. E2024 is a unique opportunity for women clergy as well as women exploring a call to pastoral ministry to connect with like-minded women clergy spanning many denominations. Many of our female clergy have attended in prior years.
